The Tecate-Tecate port of entry is one of the four ports of entry residing in San Diego County. This port serves POVs, buses, pedestrians, commercial vehicles, and rail. The U.S. Tecate border station sits on 12 acres of land while the Mexican Tecate border station sits on three acres of land. Hours of operation for these facilities are 5 a.m. to 11 p.m.
